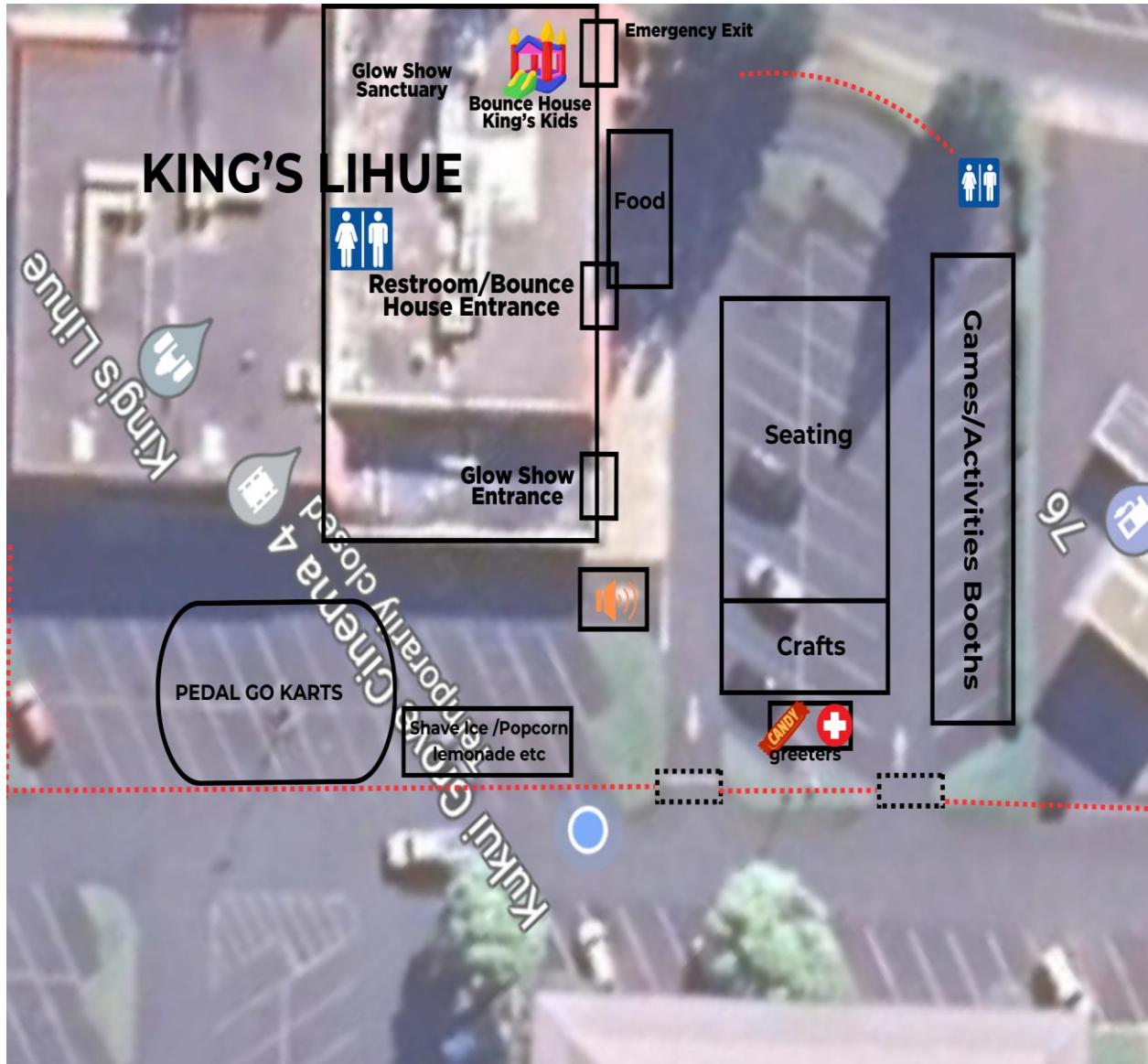

FAQ

What do I wear?

- King's T-shirt (with the current King's logo).
- Unless your booth is dressing up to go with the theme.
- Please get costumes approved by your area director prior to the event.

What if I don't have a King's shirt?

- Ask someone if you can borrow one of theirs
- See if there are any extra for purchase from the last shirt order
- Wear a shirt without brands/logos (plain or patterned)
- Keep it appropriate : we are representing King's

When do I show up?

- See the schedule for your "Call Time". Prayer is mandatory. See your team leader/area director for more information

Can I bring my own candy/prizes? Are you supplying the candy?

- Yes, but it must be pre-approved by the Games & Activities booth director
- Yes, we are supplying candy. Candy runners will be making rounds throughout the night.

Can I play the games and activities during the event if I have a booth?

- As long as you have your booth covered you are free to enjoy the event and see the other booths. However, that is also why we designate a time prior to opening for all volunteers to enjoy the other booths.
- **Minors are NOT to be left unattended at a booth at any time.**

Where do I park?

- We will have designated volunteer parking. See traffic control team and map to be provided prior to Sunday.

Can I watch the Glow Show during the event?

- If you are responsible for a booth or are on schedule to volunteer please attend to your area/volunteer assignment first. If you are not currently volunteering at that time you can attend a showing. However, we encourage everyone to come early and see the special volunteers showing at 3:30pm.
- We would like as many people in the community to see the show during one of the 4 showings throughout the event.

Important info for volunteers who are parents/guardians

Your children's safety is very important. Please make arrangements if your child / child in your care will not be helping in the area you are volunteering in. We encourage all minors to be with an adult. Minors are discouraged from being in areas such as traffic control and food booth.

If your child would like to participate in the pedal go-karts or bounce house they must pick up an orange wristband at the greeter tent and a parent or guardian must sign the waiver.

I'm all done prepping for the event... what now?

- Invite, invite, invite! Grab posters and handbills, share social media posts, invite you friends, families, neighbors, etc.
- Getting the word out is so important to bringing people in
- It's not too late!
